With Khmer New Year approaching next month, Prime Minister Hun Sen yesterday called upon Cambodians to practise safe driving habits.

⁸Do not die before welcoming the New Year god, or just welcome the [New Year] god for only an hour and then get killed,9 the prime minister said during a speech at a public inauguration for a stretch of national road in Battambang terminating at the Cambodia-Thailand border.

8Now at least five people die in a traffic accident every day, and the death [toll] will climb to 50 or 60 in 10 days.9

But irresponsible driving isnot the only reason why the Kingdomos roads are plagued by a high number of traffic accidents and deaths, said Ear Chariya, a road safety program manager for Handicap International.

The key issues leading to road crashes in Cambodia are a lack of enforcement [and] knowledge of road [rules] and [the need for] safer road design,9 Chariya said.



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
